# WE MUST NEVER MAKE PEACE WITH ABORTION

"We must never make peace with abortion." These words were spoken by one of our ministry leaders at a training earlier this year and they have stuck with me. They ring in my ears as I see how our nation and the world respond to this issue. In the training this point was emphasized by outlining the progression of abortion throughout the past few decades, not only in the U.S. but around the world.

You may be surprised to know that America is one of four countries worldwide that legally allows abortion up to birth. The other countries in that group are China, North Korea and Canada. China and North Korea also commonly practice forced abortion and are consistently guilty of violating the basic human rights of their citizens.

It's hard to imagine any scenario where we as Americans would desire to be named among such countries as North Korea and China where individual and religious freedom are virtually non-existent.

Would you know the answer if someone asked you how many lives have been taken by legalized abortion?

abortion. Every year in the world there are an estimated 40-50 million abortions, approximately 125,000 abortions per day.

In the USA, nearly half of all pregnancies are unintended and four in ten of these are terminated by abortion. There are over 3,000 abortions per day and 1,095,000 per year.

It is estimated that over the past 40 years in the U.S. approximately 65 million lives have been aborted and 1.579 billion worldwide since 1973. That is approximately 25% of the entire population.

I ask you, have we made peace with abortion? Have we as Christians, quietly accepted abortion as an answer to unplanned pregnancy? Have we turned a blind eye in an effort to seem non-judgmental? Have we begun to believe the insidious lie that in the early stages, maybe "its" not yet a life? Or maybe the child and mother really are better off now? Or maybe we were actually relieved when our child or grandchild quietly "took care of the situation", maybe we even paid for it.

We must commit again to our mission of saving the lives of our most vulnerable, by

speaking up, sharing the truth and showing support to women facing crisis pregnancy. Even if just one life is saved, it is a worthy cause.

When she is hopeless, we are ready to give her an answer for the hope which we have. When she is scared, we tell her about the only One who can provide true security. When she is anxious, we point her to the Prince of Peace. When she feels worthless, we tell her about her Savior who took her place and gave His life for hers.

This is what we have been called to brothers and sisters. When history tells her story of this age, let it be said that the followers of Christ never waived on the issue of life.

We must never make peace with abortion. We must never be okay with the killing of our children.

We even dream of future growth where we partner with physicians and nurses to offer low-cost or no-cost prenatal care, STI services and well-woman care.

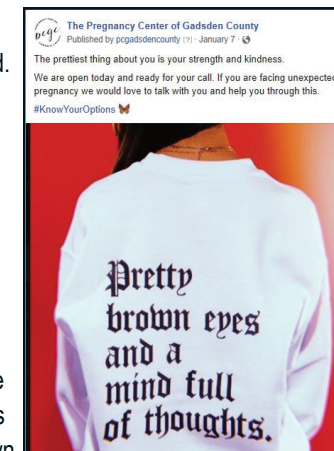
# HAVE YOU MET COURTNEY?

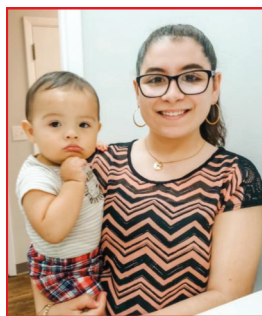
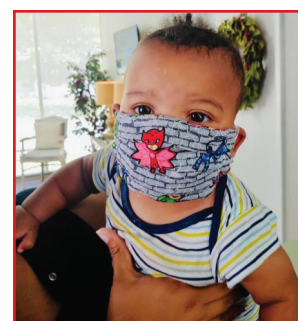
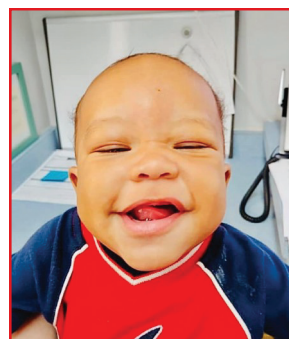
